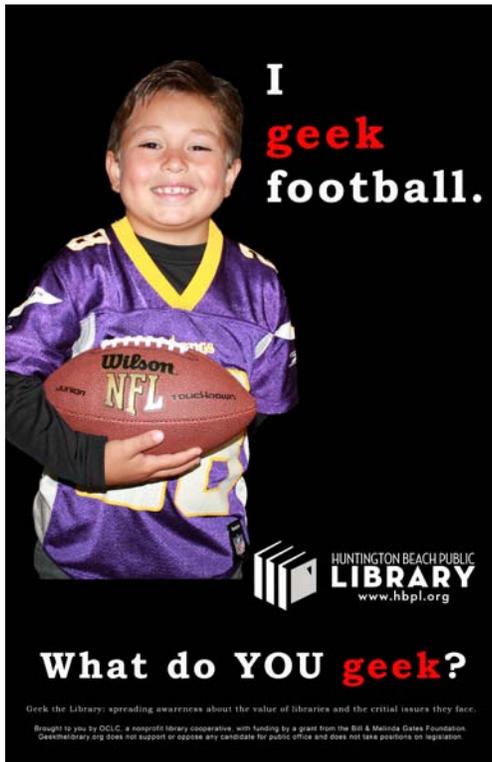


# What do YOU **geek**?
