**ORDINANCE NO. 4106  
Adopted by the City Council on NOVEMBER 7, 2016**

“AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH AMENDING CHAPTER 17.04 OF THE HUNTINGTON BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE RELATED TO THE BUILDING CODE”

SYNOPSIS:

The State mandates that every three years the building and construction codes be updated for all cities and counties throughout the State. The State adopted the 2016 California Building and Safety Codes on July 1, 2016, which must be enforced starting January 1, 2017. In order to amend the codes to meet the City of Huntington Beach's local conditions, the City is required to officially adopt the codes. On October 17, 2016, the City Council approved the introduction of the proposed Ordinances.
