# CAMP HB!

## FAQ's

### What does my child need each day?

- Sneakers or shoes with backs are mandatory every day
- 1 bag or backpack to place all items needed for camp
- Water Bottle
- Sunscreen
- A healthy lunch for your child daily including a drink
- No soda or candy please

### Does CAMP HB provide lunch?

- Lunches are provided on **Thursdays only**
- For field trip days, pack a lunch (except on Thursdays) in a DISPOSABLE BROWN PAPER BAG ONLY (with child's name on it)
- We are happy to accommodate any dietary restrictions

### Does CAMP HB provide snack?

- Camp HB provides 1 snack per day
- *We have 2 snack times per day so please provide your child with a morning snack as we provide afternoon snack*

### What activities do the campers participate in?

- Camp HB offers campers with a wide array of activities and crafts. Examples include: arts and crafts, games, sports, camp songs, etc.
- Specific day by day activities are provided to parents through the weekly camp newsletter which is distributed weekly and located by the sign in/out sheet
- Newsletters will include: field trip details, information about activities we have planned, and an additional list of items children may need for special activities

### What is the camper to counselor ratio?

- We strictly enforce a ratio 1 counselor for every 8 campers
- During water excursions we have a ratio of 1 counselor for every 6 campers

### Are CAMP HB counselors trained or certified?

- Each counselor is CPR & First Aid certified and has been trained by our camp manager

### What special items are needed for Wednesdays and Fridays (Water Days):

- Slip on shoes or crocs (flip flops, sandals, water shoes, etc) in addition to sneakers or shoes with backs
- Bathing suit
- Beach towel
- Goggles (optional)

### Does my child receive a camp shirt?

- Each camper gets one shirt; each additional shirt is \$10
- Campers are to wear camp shirts every day
- Camp shirts will be distributed on Monday
- Campers get a new shirt each week they are signed up for camp
