PADDLEBOARDING & KAYAKING SAFETY TIPS

Huntington Harbour's main boating channel is busy with boating traffic. Keep clear and exercise caution when crossing and traversing through the channels. Remember to always give passing boats the right of way.

IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY

- Do not abandon your board in the water.
- Paddle to the nearest dock for assistance. Docks in the harbour are privately owned, please do not use them unless there is an emergency.
- If you cannot paddle, wave your paddle from side to side to inform others that you need help.



GENERAL SAFETY TIPS

- 1. Know how to swim.
- 2. Make sure to have a life jacket with you (as required by law).
- 3. Wear your leash if one is available.
- 4. Stay clear of boats and always give them the right of way.
- 5. Do not disturb sea wildlife (including sea lions).
- 6. Do not use alcohol or controlled substances when engaging in recreational water activities.
