Subject: Fatal Injury Traffic Collision

Details:

On Sunday, August 7th, at about 10:53 a.m., the Huntington Beach Police Department responded to Warner Ave and Brightwater Dr regarding an injury traffic collision involving a solo motorcyclist.

Officers arrived and located an injured motorcyclist lying on the sidewalk at that intersection. The rider, a 28 year old male from Garden Grove, was unconscious and appeared to have serious injuries. Huntington Beach Fire Department paramedics responded to treat the injured rider. He was not transported to the hospital as he succumbed to his multiple injuries at the scene.

Based on the preliminary investigation, it appears the motorcyclist was riding eastbound on Warner Ave when he lost control and fell to the ground before striking a cement wall. No other vehicles are believed to be involved and the roadway was free of obvious hazards.

The investigation is ongoing and is being conducted by the HBPD Major Incident Reconstruction Team (M.I.R.T). Investigators would like to speak to anyone who might have seen the events leading up to and including the collision.
