### Details:

SUSPECT: Gordon Ray Bodkin, DOB 07-12-1966

On August 9, 2011, at about 6:30 PM, Gordon Ray Bodkin was interrupted while apparently molesting a four year old relative. This occurred while he was supposed to be babysitting, and a parent came home from work an hour early. The parent went to the rescue of the child. Gordon Bodkin, who was only wearing a t-shirt, grabbed his pants from the floor and fled out of the apartment. Gordon Ray Bodkin has not been seen since this incident.

Gordon Ray Bodkin is not known to have a vehicle and sometimes travels by bicycle. His last known addresses were in the 16100 block of Sher Lane, Huntington Beach and the 11300 block of Euclid Avenue, Garden Grove.

In addition to the above referenced crime, he is also wanted for a violation of his parole terms. The booking photo (attached) is from January 2011 when he was arrested for a DUI in Huntington Beach. Gordon Ray Bodkin still appears similar to this photograph.
