DUI Checkpoint Nets 4 Arrests

The Huntington Beach Police Department conducted a DUI/Drivers License checkpoint on Saturday, September 21, 2013 between the hours of 9:00 PM and 3:00 AM. Checkpoints are placed in locations that have the greatest opportunity for achieving drunk and drugged driving deterrence and provide the greatest safety for officers and the public.

DUI/Drivers License checkpoints help lower DUI related deaths and injuries. A major component of these checkpoints is the deterrent effects it has on those who might drive drunk or drug impaired. This brings about more awareness and encourages everyone to use sober designated drivers.

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), checkpoints have provided the most effective documented results of any of the DUI enforcement strategies. Here are some of our statistics from Saturday's checkpoint:

- 1871 Vehicles through the checkpoint
- 778 Vehicles Screened
- 2 DUI-Alcohol suspects arrested
- 2 Suspects arrested for outstanding warrants
- 8 Drivers cited/arrested for operating a vehicle unlicensed or while suspended/revoked
- 4 Other miscellaneous citations issued

Huntington Beach Police Department will be conducting another DUI/Drivers License Checkpoint on October 26th, 2013 in our ongoing commitment to lowering deaths and injuries upon our streets and highways.
