Type of Incident: Stabbing – Suspect arrested for attempted murder

Details:

On October 15, 2011, at 1:38 AM, Huntington Beach police officers responded to 911 calls in the area of Huntington Street and Rochester Avenue regarding a fight and stabbing. Police officers located the victim near Huntington Street and Adams Avenue bleeding from a severe wound to his torso. The victim was treated by Huntington Beach Fire Department paramedics at the scene and transported to Western Medical Center in Santa Ana where he is currently in stable but critical condition. The victim, a 30 year old male resident of Huntington Beach, is not being identified at this time.

Police officers were directed to where the possible suspect was. Police officers located and arrested the suspect in the 1800 block of Huntington Street as part of their investigation. A knife believed to be involved was recovered. The suspect, Eric Timothy Lund, 21, of Huntington Beach, was booked for attempted murder in the Huntington Beach Police Department city jail.

The victim and suspect were on foot walking home after being at two different local bars. The bars are not being identified at this time. An altercation took place between them and the stabbing occurred. There is no information that the victim and suspect knew each other. The investigation is continuing.
