Details:

Huntington Beach Police Department detectives actively enforce internet crimes to protect children from sexual predators. In the fall of 2010, our detectives developed information on a subject distributing child pornography using file sharing software on the internet.

On November 2, 2010, Huntington Beach Police Department detectives served a search warrant at a residence in Huntington Beach. Detectives obtained evidence of child pornography inside the residence. Our detectives arrested David Brian White, 52, pursuant to search warrant served at his house. After he was arrested, David White posted bail and had a future scheduled court date. A press release was done pursuant to this arrest and covered by local news media.

The Huntington Beach Police Department detectives submitted this case for review to the Offices of United States Attorney. The case was presented to a Federal Grand Jury and an arrest warrant was issued for David Brian White, now 53, for federal charges of possession of child pornography and distribution of child pornography. The case is now being prosecuted as a federal crime instead of a state crime.

On June 21, 2011, David White was arrested on this federal warrant by Huntington Beach detectives at a residence in Fountain Valley and booked at the Huntington Beach Police Department city jail. David White was transferred to federal custody today for his criminal arraignment.
