Details:

Missing Child: **Laylani Mosley** - Six month old female, 15 lbs, black hair, and wearing a pink onesie.

Possible Suspect: **Carolyn Ferguson** (Laylani's grandmother) 57 year old white female, 5-7, 175 lbs with blond hair and blue eyes.

Suspect Vehicle: 2007 white PT Cruiser, California license plate **5UQZ701**. The vehicle has minor front end damage.

Details:

On July 2, 2014 at 12:25 PM the Huntington Beach Police Department received a call of a missing child. A family member reported the missing child, Laylani Mosely, was last seen in her residence at 9:00 AM with Ferguson. Ferguson is the grandmother of the missing child. Ferguson has a history of mental illness and is in need of medication. It is believed that Laylani is in the company of Ferguson and their destination is unknown. Ferguson was seen today in the city of Fontana at approximately 10:00 AM in the 2007 PT Cruiser.

We are seeking the public's help in located Laylani and Ferguson and are asking anyone with information to call the Huntington Beach Police Department at 714 960-8825. An Amber Alert has been issued and if anyone sees Ferguson or her white 2007 PT Cruiser, CA. License 5UQZ701 we are asking that they call 911 immediately.

UPDATE:

On July 2, 2014 at 6:50 PM, the missing child and grandmother were located by the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office in Arizona. Both are safe and our investigators are on their way out to continue their investigation and reunite the family.
