Details:

On June 27, 2012 at about 8:15 AM, the Huntington Beach Police Department received a call of a traffic collision on Yorktown Avenue east of Beach Boulevard. Arriving officers discovered that a 2012 white Toyota Sequoia SUV collided with a 2001 maroon Saturn sedan. Based on the Preliminary investigation, it appears both vehicles were travelling east on Yorktown Ave. east of Beach Blvd.

The Saturn was occupied by a 79-year-old and a 47-year-old female, both from Huntington Beach. The occupants were treated by Huntington Beach Fire Department Paramedics and transported to UCI medical center. At the time of this release, both females remained at the hospital in critical condition. The 2012 Toyota was occupied by a solo 43-year-old female from Huntington Beach. She was interviewed by officers at the scene and was cooperative.

Yorktown Avenue, between Beach Boulevard and Newland Street, was closed to traffic for several hours. This remains an ongoing investigation and the Huntington Beach Police Department is seeking the public's help.
