Huntington Beach Police to Conduct Sobriety Checkpoint

The Huntington Beach Police Department will be making an extra effort to keep our streets safe for everyone for the Memorial Day holiday weekend with a DUI checkpoint on the night of Friday, May 25, 2007.

It is the hope of the Huntington Beach Police Department to avoid serious injury and fatal collisions over the holiday weekend by interdicting DUI drivers before they have the chance to cause a tragedy. We believe a combination of education and enforcement will save lives, making our community a better place to live and work.

Funding for this program was provided by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. The main goal of the grant is to reduce the number of persons killed or injured in alcohol-related collisions. The Huntington Beach Police Department is working in partnership with the California Office of Traffic Safety to prevent DUI related traffic incidents.
