ADVENTURE and FUN await students through the Sister City Student Exchange Program. High school freshmen, sophomores and juniors who live in Huntington Beach OR attend any of the Huntington Beach Union High School District schools are eligible.

• Why should students apply to be a part of the student exchange program?

This is an outstanding opportunity for students and their families to develop an understanding and long-lasting friendship with citizens of Japan through a reciprocal family living experience.

• What are some of the benefits gained from participating?

Any travel is broadening, as is being immersed in a completely different culture. Former students have said it was the most memorable summer of his life. • How does the student exchange program work?
