**ORDINANCE NO. 4129
Adopted by the City Council on APRIL 17, 2017**

“AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH AMENDING CHAPTER 8.21 OF THE HUNTINGTON BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO REFUSE MANAGEMENT”

SYNOPSIS:

Ordinance number 4129 relates to refuse management per HBMC Chapter 8.21. The intent was to keep the existing language regarding trash disposal but added another section that specifically prohibits the discard of infectious waste including hypodermic needles, syringes, diapers, materials that have been infected with human or animal waste, contaminated materials exposed to infected materials and unused or unwanted prescription medications or controlled substances. These additional provisions will further define and enhance our ability to deal with particular problems encountered by our officers and the public in regard to waste.
