Opened in 1974, and named after Dr. Donald Shipley, the Shipley Nature Center is eighteen acres of protected wilderness area surrounded by Central Park. The Center consists of 3/4 mile of self-guided trails and the Visitors' Center where Trail Guides are available. The main trail is 1/2 mile long.

Although the majority of visitors use the Trail Guide and roam the Center on their own, tours can be arranged by calling 848-8810.

The Center is located west of Golden West at the extreme north end of the park. The best way to reach it is to drive down Edwards to Central Park Drive, then follow Central Park Drive until it ends in a parking lot. Park and follow the signs to the Shipley Nature Center.
