COUNTY OF ORANGE HISTORY

Although what is known today as Orange County had been populated by Indians for thousands of years, it was not until 1769 that Gaspar de Portola and his expedition became the first white men to set foot on County soil. The men crossed the County from San Clemente to Brea leaving their mark on our heritage by naming such things as Trabuco Canyon, Santa Ana and Santiago Creek.

Author Richard Henry Dana visited the coastline in 1835 aboard a ship dealing in tanning hides which was a by-product of the lucrative cattle business in early Orange County's history. Dana immortalized the County with his famous novel "Two Years Before the Mast."

By the 1880's businessmen sought independence from Los Angeles County of which Orange County land had been part since statehood. Attempts to separate finally succeeded in 1889 when William Spurgeon and James W. McFadden lobbied a bill through the Legislature. This authorized a split from Los Angeles if the voters agreed. And agree they did as the vote of June 4, 1889 carried 2,505 to 499. The new County was called Orange and consisted of three cities: Anaheim (1878), Santa Ana (1886) and Orange (1888) as well as 10 towns, four railroads, 15 miles of trolley rails and 13,600 residents. Santa Ana was voted as the County Seat while Spurgeon was chosen Chairman of the first Board of Supervisors.

Orange County had grown to 216,224 people in 1950 when the completion of the Santa Ana Freeway, the opening of Disneyland, and the increased industrialization caused another land boom and the population to soar to 703,925 by 1960. The acceleration continued and on September 30, 1963 Orange County received its one millionth resident when Derek Frank DeBano was born in Anaheim. Times changed and citrus groves became housing tracts. Where land once was farmed, schools sprang up to handle the increased educational needs. By 1970 the population had reached 1.4 million and in the late 1980's the population soared to over two million two hundred thousand people in Orange County.

With these rapid changes the County has had to discard traditional approaches and take on new approaches to government. Through a long-range parks campaign, for instance, the County has purchased 10 large regional parks as well as various beaches in an effort to maintain some of our rural heritage. The intent of preserving large parks for open space enables the County to take a progressive step into the future while still keeping an eye on our past.
