Be **Red Cross** Ready


Prepare so you can protect.

- Topics available: Preparedness Essentials, Earthquakes, Wildfires, Home Fires, and more!

- 1 hour presentation of 1-2 topics for 25 or more people

Hands-Only CPR

- Providing skills for bystanders
- 30-minute non-certification presentation
- Participants will learn how to:
 - Determine when compressions are necessary
 - · Check for scene safety
 - Administer chest compressions
- Hands-on practice ensures participants feel comfortable with skill



Youth Preparedness



- Audience: Elementary Students
- Part of the Home Fire Campaign
- Presentations encourage students to learn, practice, and share emergency preparedness information with their community
- Students learn skills to prepare for a home fire and to keep themselves calm
- Available for schools, clubs, after school programs, and community groups


Youth Preparedness Presentations

Pillowcase Project

- 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade
- 1-hour presentation
- General preparedness tips for home fires: smoke alarms, escape plan, communication plan
- Local Hazard information (earthquakes or wildfires)
- Each participant provided tools to build their own emergency kit


Prepare with Pedro

- Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd grade
- 45-minute presentation
- Home Fire preparedness tips
 - Smoke Alarms
 - Escape plan
 - Meeting Place
- Storybook format with Pedro the Penguin and his friends
