Subject: Fatal Traffic Collision

Details:

On Sunday, November 18, 2018, at about 8:42 am, the Huntington Beach Police Department responded to the area of Edwards Street and Central Park Drive regarding a traffic collision involving a bicyclist and a vehicle.

Upon arrival, officers discovered the bicyclist, a 78-year-old male from Huntington Beach, had sustained major injuries. He was transported to UCI Medical Center where he was admitted in critical condition.

The involved vehicle, a black 2017 Jeep Cherokee, was driven by a 28-year-old female from Huntington Beach. She remained at the scene and is cooperating with the investigation.

Based on the preliminary investigation, it appears the bicyclist was traveling east in the intersection and the vehicle was traveling north when they collided.

On Wednesday, November 21, 2018, the bicyclist succumbed to his injuries at UCI Medical Center and was pronounced deceased.
