### **Details:**

On July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2013, shortly after the conclusion of the Vans US Open of Surfing, a large disturbance took place in the downtown area of Huntington Beach which included numerous fights, acts of vandalism, thefts, burglary and several arson fires. The disturbance ultimately required the response of approximately 250 police officers to control.

Follow up investigation is ongoing regarding crimes that were committed during the disturbance. With the help of information provided by the public, we identified Eliyau Rueven Jackson, DOB 11-2-92, as one of the participants who damaged newspaper stands and City of Huntington Beach Public Work's Trucks.

Today, Jackson turned himself in to detectives from the Huntington Beach Police Department. Jackson was arrested for felony vandalism, PC 594(b)(1), inciting a riot, PC 404.6a, and refusing to disperse when ordered, PC 416(a).

Jackson was booked into the Huntington Beach City Jail pursuant to an arrest warrant for the above listed charges on \$20,000 bail. The Huntington Beach Police Department remains committed to identifying and arresting anyone engaged in unlawful behavior occurring during this incident.
