the female while she was crossing the street near the intersection of BROOKHURST and MERIDITH. The pedestrian fell to the ground and was struck by another vehicle. Upon getting out of her vehicle the second motorist realized she had struck a pedestrian and immediately called the police. The driver of the first vehicle initially left the scene, but returned and was interviewed by investigating officers.

Alcohol is not suspected in this traffic collision. The investigation is on going at this time and all names and vehicle descriptions are being withheld at this time.
